Dr. T.V. Sekher is Professor and Head of the Department of Population Policies and Programs at the International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), Mumbai, India. He is the Principal Investigator of the Longitudinal Ageing Study in India (LASI) and the Study on Global AGEing and Adult Health (SAGE-India). Dr. Sekher was Fulbright-Nehru Senior Fellow (2016-17) at Cornell University, USA. He has authored and edited ten books, and has more than 100 research articles in national and international journals. He was consultant to Govt. of India, UNFPA, UNICEF and other organizations. Currently Prof. Sekher is the President of the Indian Association for Social Sciences and Health (IASSH), a professional association of more than 1400 social scientists working on health and development issues in India.
